Overview

This eight-week course will provide students with the vocational and soft skills training needed to successfully pursue competitive employment in entry-level positions at Natoli Engineering in St. Charles, Missouri.

Coursework begins at the Skills Center and then moves to Natoli in week two where students also begin full-time work as paid employees. Three hours each workday will count toward the training requirements of the Skills Center's manufacturing program, including one hour dedicated solely to soft skills. Students will earn a Skills Center Certificate of Completion for successfully finishing all coursework.

What Are the Work Requirements?

Prospective students must have a high school diploma or equivalent and pass a basic background check through Natoli. Students must be able to stand and walk for eight hours each workday and be able to lift, handle and carry trays weighing up to 50 pounds.

Students must successfully complete the training program and meet all Natoli Engineering hiring requirements in order to earn job offers.
