Health Care & Social Assistance Support Program **Barnes-Jewish West County Hospital**

This seven-week course provides students with the vocational and soft skills training needed to successfully pursue competitive full-time employment as a Housekeeper with BJC Healthcare at Barnes-Jewish West County Hospital in Creve Coeur or St. Louis Children's Hospital or Christian Hospital in St. Louis. This course meets Monday-Friday afternoons for three hours a day for six weeks and six hours a day for week seven. BJC Healthcare is one of the largest nonprofit health care integrated delivery organizations in the country.

- » Training held at Barnes-Jewish West County Hospital
- » Students will learn how to clean and prepare patient and post-anesthesia rooms and common areas
- » Students must pass a BJC drug screen and background check and be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 and flu and able to stand for eight hours each workday
- » Starting wage is \$15/hour with day, evening, or night shifts available
- » Training is accredited by the Missouri Department of Higher Education
- » County or state funding typically covers tuition costs—scholarship funds may also be available
- » Students must successfully complete the course and meet all pre-hiring requirements to earn a job offer
