We are enrolling students for the following training course. Tuition funding is available.

Warehouse Program General Training

This general training course will provide students with the vocational and soft skills training needed to successfully secure competitive, integrated employment with one of our warehouse employment partners. This six-week course meets Monday-Friday for four hours each day.

- » Students prepared for full- or part-time warehouse positions
- » Students learn forklift operation and safety as well as general safety, lean warehouse, inventory procedures
- » Students learn how to pick products with the use of a robot, packout procedures, box build, load and unload trucks, and receiving procedures
- » Warehouse training held at DM in St. Peters, Mo. and forklift training held at BCI in St. Peters, Mo.
- » Training is accredited by the Missouri Department of Higher Education
- » County or state funding typically covers tuition costs—scholarship funds may also be available
- » Students must successfully complete the course and meet all pre-hiring requirements to earn a job offer
- » Starting wage dependent upon employment partner job offer (near or within the \$15-16/hour)
