- » Students prepared for part- or full-time Shop Assistant positions (working 6:30AM-3PM, Monday-Friday)
- » Starting wage \$16-17/hour
- » Students train on-site at Emerson for 6 weeks (4 hours a day, including 1 hour of soft skills training)
- » Students learn to build kits, stock lines, pack/unpack materials, prepare shipments, monitor quality, maintain an organized and safe workspace, and adhere to quality standards
- » Training is accredited by the Missouri Department of Higher Education 
- » County or state funding typically covers tuition cost—scholarship funds may also be available
- » Students must pass a drug screen and background check and be able to stand for 8 hours a shift and lift up to 49 lbs. on a semi-regular basis
- » Students must successfully complete course and meet all pre-hiring requirements in order to earn job offer
