Manufacturing Program

Watlow Electric Manufacturing Co.

This six-week course equips students with disabilities with the vocational and soft skills necessary to secure competitive integrated employment at Watlow Electric. Watlow designs and manufactures heating solutions consisting primarily of electric resistive heaters, temperature sensors, temperature and power controllers and supporting software – all the components of a thermal system.

- » Students prepared for part- or full-time Operator positions with a starting wage of \$18.46/hour
- » Students train four hours a day the first two to three weeks at BCI in St. Peters and then move to Watlow's Maryland Heights campus (12001 Lackland Rd., 63146) for the remainder of the course
- » Students learn to use an electronic sewing machine, sew by hand, read schematics and drawings, cut materials using a laser cutter, and perform basic math
- » Students also learn soft skills (communication, teamwork, expectations, personal finance) 1 hour a day
- » Training is accredited by the Missouri Department of Higher Education 
- » County or state funding typically covers tuition cost—scholarship funds may also be available
- » Students must successfully complete course and meet all pre-hiring requirements in order to earn job offer
