Custodial Program Fort Zumwalt School District

This six-week course equips individuals with disabilities with the skills necessary to secure competitive integrated employment with the Fort Zumwalt School District. This course serves as the Related Technical Instruction (RTI) required for registered apprenticeship preparation—connecting training to long-term career advancement.

- » Participants are prepared for part-time, full-time, or substitute Custodian positions that start at \$15/hour
- » Participants train four hours a day (Monday–Friday), learning to clean classrooms, restrooms, offices, common areas, and other high-touch areas
- » Participants receive additional instruction in soft skills, including communication, teamwork, workplace expectations, and personal finance
- » Training is recognized by the Missouri Department of Higher Education
- » County or state funding typically covers tuition costs; scholarship funds may also be available
- » Participants must successfully complete the course and meet all requirements to be eligible for hire
- » Hired individuals may choose to continue into a registered apprenticeship, completing 2,000 hours of paid on-the-job training (approximately one year) to earn an industry-recognized credential
